

House Bill No. 5274

Public Act No. 18-162

AN ACT CONCERNING THE TERMS OF THE STATE POET LAUREATE AND THE STATE TROUBADOUR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 3-110f of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2018*):

The [Department] <u>Commissioner</u> of Economic and Community Development, with recommendations of the Culture and Tourism Advisory Committee, [may appoint] <u>shall designate, every three years,</u> a state poet laureate. <u>The commissioner may fill any vacancy by</u> <u>appointment for the unexpired portion of the term vacated.</u>

Sec. 2. Section 3-110h of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2018*):

There shall be an official state troubadour <u>or trobairitz</u>. The [Department] <u>Commissioner</u> of Economic and Community Development shall [biennially] designate, <u>every three years</u>, a troubadour <u>or trobairitz</u> to serve in the position. <u>The commissioner may fill any vacancy by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term vacated</u>.
