

Substitute Senate Bill No. 1088

Public Act No. 19-42

AN ACT CONCERNING PARTICIPATION BY A RESIDENT OF A NURSING HOME FACILITY OR RESIDENTIAL CARE HOME IN A RECEIVERSHIP PROCEEDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 19a-542 of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*, 2019):

(b) A resident of a nursing home facility or residential care home for which an application to appoint a receiver has been filed or such resident's legally liable relative, conservator or guardian may appear as a party to the proceedings. <u>The court shall permit a resident of a</u> <u>nursing home facility or residential care home that is the subject of an</u> <u>application for receivership, or the resident's legally liable relative,</u> <u>conservator or guardian, to be heard at the hearing on the application</u> <u>for receivership without having to file an appearance as a party.</u>
