contract in this state for a loan or loans pursuant to said act. The claim of infancy shall not be pleaded in any action arising out of any loan made pursuant to the provisions of such act.

SEC. 2. Sections 809h to 812h of the 1945 supplement to the general statutes are repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect July 7, 1947; but nothing herein shall impair or restrict the obligation or enforceability of any contract lawfully made prior to the effective date of this act.

PUBLIC ACT NO. 319

AN ACT CONCERNING THE VETERANS' HOME AND HOSPITAL.

Wherever in the general statutes or any supplement thereto the words "veterans' home" or "Fitch's Home for the Soldiers" appear, the words "veterans' home and hospital" shall be substituted in lieu thereof; and wherever the words "veterans' home commission" appear the words "veterans' home and hospital commission" shall be substituted in lieu thereof.

PUBLIC ACT NO. 320

AN ACT CONCERNING FUNERAL ALLOWANCES OF OLD AGE ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES.

Subsection (b) of section 390g of the 1943 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof: Upon the death of a beneficiary, the commissioner of welfare may order the payment of a sum not to exceed one hundred dollars as an allowance toward the funeral expenses of such deceased beneficiary, unless such deceased left sufficient estate, or had insurance on his life, carried by himself or a legally liable relative, to provide a proper burial, and in addition may order the payment of a sum not to exceed twenty-five dollars for the cost of a burial lot, the opening of the grave and other cemetery charges or cremation expense.
