AN ACT CONCERNING THE QUALITY AND DELIVERY OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Education

2 shall conduct a study about special education in the state. Not later than

3 May 20, 2025, the commissioner shall submit a report of the results of

- 4 such study to the select committee of the General Assembly having
- 5 cognizance of matters relating to special education, in accordance with
- 6 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.
