The Committee on Government Administration and Elections reported through REP. BLUMENTHAL of the 147th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT REQUIRING THE ONLINE POSTING OF STATUTORILY
REQUIRED STATE AGENCY REPORTS TO THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 11-4a of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

3 Each commission, task force or committee appointed by the Governor
4 or the General Assembly, or both, and required to report its findings and
5 recommendations, and each state agency which submits a report to the
6 General Assembly or any committee of the General Assembly, shall (1)
7 submit its report electronically to the clerks of the Senate and the House
8 of Representatives and the Office of Legislative Research, [and shall] (2)
9 file one copy with the State Librarian, and (3) in the case of a state
10 agency, post such report on the Internet web site of such state agency.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

This bill requires a state agency that submits a report to the legislature or a legislative committee to also post the report on the agency's website. By law, unchanged by the bill, an agency must also (1) submit the report electronically to the Office of Legislative Research and the clerks of the House and Senate and (2) file a copy with the state librarian.
