The Committee on Planning and Development reported through REP. KAVROS DEGRAW of the 17th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT DISSOLVING THE LAURA ANDREWS FREE LIBRARY ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2025*) The Laura Andrews Free Library Association, established pursuant to number 134 of the special acts of 1880, as amended by number 30 of the special acts of 1892, is hereby dissolved. The funds and tangible property held by such association shall be transferred to the town of Thomaston for the benefit of the Thomaston Public Library.
- Sec. 2. Number 134 of the special acts of 1880 and number 30 of the
 special acts of 1892 are repealed. (*Effective October 1, 2025*)

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
