The Committee on Veterans' and Military Affairs reported through SEN. HONIG of the 8th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

## ***AN ACT DESIGNATING NATIONAL WOMEN VETERANS RECOGNITION DAY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the general statutes is  
2       amended by adding subdivision (118) as follows (*Effective from passage*):  
  
3       (NEW) (118) The Governor shall proclaim June twelfth of each year  
4       as National Women Veterans Recognition Day, to recognize the  
5       significant contributions of women who bravely and honorably served  
6       in the United States armed forces. Suitable exercises may be held in the  
7       State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the  
8       observance of the day.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
