The Committee on Commerce reported through SEN. HARTLEY of the 15th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING WORKFORCE SHORTAGES, WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic and
2 Community Development shall conduct a study of workforce shortages,
3 workforce development and training availability. Such study shall
4 include, but need not be limited to, an analysis of the effect of such
5 shortages, development and availability on commercial activity in the
6 state. Not later than January 1, 2026, the commissioner shall submit a
7 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
8 statutes, on the results of such study to the joint standing committee of
9 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
10 commerce.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
