The Committee on Labor and Public Employees reported through SEN. KUSHNER of the 24th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE DOMESTIC WORKERS EDUCATION AND TRAINING GRANTS PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2025*) The sum of five hundred thousand dollars is appropriated to the Labor Department from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, for the domestic workers education and training grants program established pursuant to section 31-71*l* of the general statutes.

6 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2025*) The sum of five hundred thousand 7 dollars is appropriated to the Labor Department from the General Fund, 8 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, for the domestic workers 9 education and training grants program established pursuant to section 10 31-71*l* of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Explanation

The bill appropriates \$500,000 to the Labor Department for the domestic workers education and training grants program for each of FY 26 and FY 27. There is no associated cost with the program administration as it currently exists within the agency. ARPA funds in the amount of \$400,000 (\$200,000 in each of FY 22 FY 23) have been allocated for this program previously.
