- 3 Court, District of Connecticut, Civil Action No. 3:22CV322, dated
- 4 January 9, 2025, requiring an expenditure from the General Fund budget
- 5 in excess of two million five hundred thousand dollars and submitted
- 6 by the Attorney General to this Assembly for approval in accordance
- 7 with section 3-125a of the general statutes, is approved.
