Explanation

The bill allows employees from the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station (CAES) to participate in activities, and be compensated for products related to their work, from start-up companies. The bill could result in a potential revenue gain as it allows the CAES to share proceeds from an employee's work. The extent of the revenue would vary based on the compensation received by any employee.

The bill also makes various procedural changes that are not anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the agency.

House "A" results in the potential revenue gain described above, as it allows CAES to share proceeds from an employee's work.
