Explanation

The bill, which eliminates the prohibition on sports betting with regard to Connecticut intercollegiate teams, results in an estimated annualized General Fund revenue gain of between \$200,000 and \$1 million beginning in FY 26.¹

House "A" strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact and replaces it with the impact outlined above.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to wagering frequency and amounts.
