## Municipal Impact: None

## Explanation

The bill, which requires the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP) to waive and cover the cost of fees associated with background checks for indigent persons seeking a pardon, results in a cost to the state beginning in FY 26.

The waiver applies to the following fees:

- 1. the convenience fee for fingerprinting of up to \$30 charged by independent contractors,
- 2. any processing or distribution fees charged for a criminal history report, and
- 3. any fee for electronically preregistering with the Connecticut

criminal history request system.1

It is unknown how many individuals will apply for this waiver.

#### The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the number of fees waived.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Ordinarily, this fee totals \$88.25 (or \$90.90 with a credit card). Existing law already allows DESPP to waive a \$75 portion of this fee for a state criminal history report, leaving a remainder of \$13.25 to be waived (and presumably covered by DESPP) for the federal report.
