### AN ACT CONCERNING GRANTS FOR THE REMOVAL OF PFAS FROM FIRE APPARATUS.

#### ***Explanation***

The bill allows the unexpended funds for the removal of PFAS from fire apparatus to be carried forward from FY 25 to FY 26, while also expanding eligibility to include independent fire companies and state agencies and allowing reimbursement for any PFAS removal that occurred prior to July 1, 2023. It is estimated that approximately \$1.5 million of these funds will remain unspent at the end of FY 25.<sup>1</sup>

The bill also results in a potential revenue gain to various state agencies and various municipalities that request and receive

reimbursement for PFAS removal.
