### Municipal Impact: None

### Explanation

The bill creates an unclassified misdemeanor for driving above 100 mph which results in a potential cost to the Judicial Department for probation and a potential revenue gain to the General Fund from fines. On average, the marginal cost for supervision in the community is less than \$600<sup>1</sup> each year for adults and \$450 each year for juveniles.

### The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the actual number of violations.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Probation marginal cost is based on services provided by private providers and only includes costs that increase with each additional participant. This does not include a cost for additional supervision by a probation officer unless a new offense is anticipated to result in enough additional offenders to require additional probation officers.
