Explanation

The bill as amended requires a specific review and approval process for any amendment to the Medicaid state plan to provide medical assistance through a Medicaid managed care organization, including the advice and consent of the General Assembly. To the extent this delays or prevents a change that otherwise would have occurred, the state could experience a fiscal impact that cannot be determined at this time.

Senate "A" strikes the language in the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact and results in the fiscal impact stated above.

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to inflation.
