Explanation

The bill allows municipalities to (1) adopt an ordinance prohibiting street takeovers and (2) seize vehicles used to violate the ordinance and sell them at a public auction.

The bill results in a potential cost to municipalities beginning in FY 26 to the extent they choose to adopt this ordinance to enforce the ordinance and sell vehicles at the public auction.

There is also a potential revenue gain to municipal police departments beginning in FY 26 associated with the sale of vehicles at an auction as the bill requires these funds be used to support the municipality's police department or the resident state trooper serving the municipality.
