## ***OFA Fiscal Note***

***Municipal Impact:*** None

### ***Explanation***

The bill, which prohibits distributing or selling certain smoke detection and warning equipment, results in a minimal potential revenue gain to the state beginning in FY 26 to the extent violations occur and the penalties are enforced.<sup>1</sup> The bill does not specify who oversees enforcement.

### ***The Out Years***

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the number of violations.

<sup>1</sup> Under the bill, a first violation is subject to a fine of up to \$100 and subsequent violations are subject to fines of up to \$500.
