Explanation

The bill makes a variety of changes related to the Department of Agriculture (DoAg).

The bill results in a minimal revenue gain to the resources of the General Fund, beginning in FY 26, associated with a fee for soil amendment registrations. The bill sets the fee at an amount to be determined by the DoAg commissioner, up to \$75. It is estimated that there would be less than 300 soil registrations annually, resulting in a minimal revenue gain.

Additionally, the bill results in a minimal cost to municipalities. The bill allows the DoAg commissioner to charge municipalities the actual cost to obtain and distribute dog tags, rather than five cents per tag (current law). It is estimated that the actual cost for this service is seven cents per tag, a two-cent increase. The increased cost to municipalities is anticipated to be minimal.
