REASONS FOR BILL:

This bill looks to create a specialty license plate available to women veterans and service members in order to commemorate women veterans. Given how little recognition women veterans get for their service compared to their male counterparts, creating a specialty license plate for women veterans would help honor them and encourage young women seeking to enlist.

The substitute language of this bill changes the language to mirror the language establishing a specialty veterans' license plate.
