REASONS FOR BILL:

This bill requires a person who parks a trailer, that is used for landscaping purposes on a public highway, to place traffic cones around the trailer in a way that aligns with the manual uniform traffic control devices and makes any violation of this requirement an infraction. Individuals have reported numerous close calls where cars have narrowly avoided landscaping vehicles parked on the side of the road. This bill aims to ensure and monitor the protection and safety of the residents, workers, and their vehicles on state roads that have high residential populations and feature limited access for landscaping vehicles to park in driveways.
