This bill would establish a radon mitigation assistance program for low-income households through the Department of Housing and its 'Healthy Homes Fund'.

NATURE AND SOURCES OF SUPPORT:

<u>Ruth Canovi, Director of Advocacy, American Lung Association in Connecticut</u>: Ms. Canovi stated in her testimony that exposure to radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States and that testing for radon is "relatively easy and inexpensive." Ms. Canovi concluded by stating that the Department of Housing and the Department of Public Health should work in a partnership to enact this legislation if enacted.
