To make modifications to the public safety statutes.

Section 1. Subsection C of section 7-323k of the general statutes is repealed and two grammatical changes have been made from the words [one year] to one-year.

In section 2. Subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 29-252 of the general 18 statutes is repealed and the word [said] is replaced with the words the State to specify the object or thing begin referenced.

Changes the language in Section 1 Subsection F (1) from [a] to any.
