## SUBSTITUTE LANGUAGE:

The substitute language removes former section 11 from the bill and lines 444-446, which was former section 13(e). It bifurcates former section 14, now section 13, so that subsection (a) deals with the penalty for the sale of cannabis to persons under 21, and subsection (b) deals with the sale of cannabis paraphernalia to persons under age 21. The penalty in what was section 15 of the file copy, which is now section 14, remains the same as the file copy, a class E felony.
