REASONS FOR BILL:

The reason for this bill is to increase the per diem pay for members of the State Board of Labor Relations from \$150 to \$300 per day.

The JFS Language: additionally increases compensation for the Board of Mediation and Arbitration, with that pay increase dependent on the composition of arbitration and mediation panels, and the particular services provided throughout the process.
