REASONS FOR BILL:

This bill proposes a series of minor technical changes to existing statutes affecting the well-being of children. If passed, all sections of the act would take effect on July 1st, 2025.

Section one addresses changes to council meetings, Section two addresses judicial relief procedures, Section three addresses licensure for caregivers in kin placements, Section four addresses guardianship in protective placements, Section five addresses interstate placements, Section six addresses the review of protective supervision orders.
