REASONS FOR BILL:

Due to a trend of medical tax issues for children's hospitals compared to general hospitals, it is hopeful that by creating an exemption for children's hospitals, it will help to resolve such issues.

NATURE AND SOURCES OF SUPPORT:

Shmerling, Jim, President and CEO of CT Children's

Mr. Shmerling submits testimony in support of this bill, sharing a quick history and detail of CT Children's Hospital, and going on to state their relationship with Medicaid compared to general (adult) hospitals. Mr. Shmerling goes on to express that CT Children's is seeking the removal of current statutory exemption from the tax, to enable their participation beginning Fiscal Year 2027. He believes this should benefit the state by leveraging additional federal Medicaid revenue and will align Connecticut's tax with the rest of the country since most states include their children's hospital as part of their hospital tax programs.
