ADDENDUM

To Fiscal Note on
sHB-6835, File No. 14

AN ACT ADOPTING THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT LICENSURE COMPACT.

The fiscal note on the underlying bill indicates a General Fund revenue loss of approximately \$80,000 in FY 26 and \$178,000 in FY 27. This is the result of the Department of Public Health losing revenues collected from physician assistants (PAs) residing in other Compact states who currently pay for licensure in Connecticut.

This revenue loss may be partially offset to the extent the state charges a fee to PAs for granting compact privilege. Currently, the state does not directly charge a separate fee for privileges granted by similar interstate occupational compacts.
