AN ACT CONCERNING HOUSING AND THE NEEDS OF HOMELESS PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Housing shall
2 conduct a study on initiatives to lower housing costs, increase housing
3 options and better support persons experiencing homelessness in the
4 state. Not later than January 1, 2026, the commissioner shall report the
5 results of the study, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
6 of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General
7 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing. Such report
8 may include the commissioner's recommendations for legislation
9 regarding lowering housing costs, increasing housing options and
10 better supporting persons experiencing homelessness in the state.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
