AN ACT CONCERNING THE CALCULATION OF THE TEN PER CENT THRESHOLD FOR THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING APPEALS PROCEDURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That subsection (k) of section 8-30g of the general statutes be amended to include in the calculation of the ten per cent threshold for the affordable housing appeals procedure any properties that are not deed restricted but are able to be purchased by individuals or families whose income is less than or equal to eighty per cent of the median income based on the prevailing interest rate and appraised values of properties in effect as of the prior grand list year.

Statement of Purpose:

To include dwelling units that meet certain income requirements in the calculation of the ten per cent threshold for the affordable housing appeals procedure.
