AN ACT BANNING THE USE OF NUTRALOAF OR A PUNITIVE DIET AS A DISCIPLINARY TOOL IN CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 18 of the general statutes be amended to (1) ban the feeding
- 2 of nutraloaf or similar punitive diets to persons who are incarcerated as
- 3 a disciplinary tool, (2) require the Commissioner of Correction to ensure
- 4 all correctional facilities serve nutritious and palatable meals to all
- 5 incarcerated persons.

To ban the feeding of nutraloaf or similar punitive diets to persons who are incarcerated as a disciplinary tool and require the Commissioner of Correction to ensure all correctional facilities serve nutritious and palatable meals to all incarcerated persons.
