**AN ACT CONCERNING THE OBSERVANCE OF THREE KINGS DAY IN  
CONNECTICUT PUBLIC SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to permit students in
- 2 grades kindergarten to twelve, inclusive, to not attend school in order
- 3 to observe Three Kings Day; and further, that section 10-198b of the
- 4 general statutes be amended to require the State Board of Education to
- 5 amend the definitions of "excused absence" and "unexcused absence" to
- 6 exclude a student's observance of Three Kings Day.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To recognize the cultural and religious significance of Three Kings Day  
for students in Connecticut.
