**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON PERMITS TO BURN  
MEDICAL WASTE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a moratorium on
- 2 the approval of permits for the burning of medical waste to allow the
- 3 Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to work with the
- 4 Department of Public Health to assess any risks associated with such
- 5 permits and develop attendant health and safety standards.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To mitigate risks associated with medical waste burning and protect the  
health and safety of residents in the state.
