AN ACT REQUIRING THE INCLUSION OF A MINIMUM READING PROFICIENCY LEVEL AS PART OF THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-221a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 students to read at a minimum reading proficiency level of an eighth-
- 3 grade level in order to graduate from high school.

Statement of Purpose:

To require high school graduates to be able to read at a minimum of an eighth-grade reading level.
