AN ACT ESTABLISHING A RECOVERY SCHOOL IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 State Board of Education to establish and operate a state-wide recovery
- 3 school that is designed specifically for students in grades nine to twelve,
- 4 inclusive, who are in recovery from substance use disorder or co-
- 5 occurring disorders.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure educational and treatment opportunities for high school students in recovery.
