**AN ACT CONCERNING MOTOR VEHICLE DATA PRIVACY AND
VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that a motor vehicle
- 2 manufacturer shall (1) terminate, free of charge, an individual's access
- 3 to remote vehicle technology if a driver of the motor vehicle equipped
- 4 with such technology provides to such manufacturer (A) proof that such
- 5 driver is in legal possession of, and has the exclusive right to use, such
- 6 motor vehicle, or (B) a restraining order issued against the individual
- 7 whose access is to be restricted, (2) establish an efficient, secure and
- 8 user-friendly online submission process to process requests to terminate
- 9 such access, and (3) equip each motor vehicle such manufacturer
- 10 manufactures with an indicator indicating whether such technology is
- 11 in use.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for the termination of, and require disclosure regarding the
use of, remote vehicle technology.
