AN ACT REQUIRING PAYMENT OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES AS A PRECONDITION TO PROFESSIONAL AND OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE RENEWALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 20 of the general statutes be amended to provide that no 2 state board, office or agency shall renew any professional or 3 occupational license issued by or on behalf of the state unless the 4 applicant for such renewal demonstrates that such applicant does not 5 owe any taxes assessed against any personal property that such 6 applicant uses in the course of such applicant's profession or occupation.

Statement of Purpose:

To require an applicant seeking renewal of a professional or occupational license to demonstrate that the applicant does not owe any taxes assessed against the personal property that such applicant uses in the course of such applicant's profession or occupation.
