AN ACT CONCERNING USE OF DEADLY FORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That subsection (c) of section 53a-22 of the general statutes be amended to provide that use of deadly force upon another person by a peace officer or an authorized official of the Department of Correction or the Board of Pardons and Paroles is justified if a reasonable officer or official would use such force given the facts and circumstances known to the officer or official at the time, instead of requiring such force be objectively reasonable under the given circumstances at the time.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that peace officers are properly evaluated for the use of force.
