## AN ACT CONCERNING EARLY VOTING FOR SINGULAR, UNCONTESTED SPECIAL ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that, whenever a special election is to be held in a municipality for purposes of filling a singular vacancy in a municipal office, where such election is the lone race to appear on the ballot and only one candidate is running to fill such singular vacancy such that the election is uncontested, such municipality may opt out of conducting a period of early voting for such special election.

## Statement of Purpose:

To allow municipalities to opt out of conducting early voting for singular, uncontested special elections.
