AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ELECTRONIC PORTAL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR STATE GRANT PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Section 4-68dd of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 3 (a) [The] Not later than July 1, 2026, the Secretary of the Office of 4 Policy and Management shall, within available appropriations,
- 5 establish and maintain a single electronic portal available on the Internet
- 6 and located on the Office of Policy and Management's Internet web site
- 7 concerning grants administered or provided by state agencies for the
- 8 purpose of posting all state-funded [municipal] grant applications. Such
- 9 electronic portal shall be known as the [Municipal] <u>State</u> Grant Portal.
- 10 (b) The [Municipal] <u>State</u> Grant Portal shall include, but not be
- limited to: (1) All state-funded [municipal] grant applications, [and
- 12 municipal reimbursement request forms,] (2) a searchable database for
- locating information regarding state-funded [municipal] grants, [and]
- 14 (3) an Internet web page dedicated to state-funded municipal grant

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- 15 applications and municipal reimbursement request forms, and (4)
- 16 features to encourage the active recruitment and participation of
- 17 municipalities and other interested parties in the state-funded

18 [municipal] grant application process.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
