AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700c of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 individual and group health insurance policies to provide coverage for
- 3 emergency medical services, regardless of whether the covered person
- 4 is transported when medically necessary by ambulance to a hospital.

To require individual and group health insurance policies to provide coverage for emergency medical services, regardless of whether the covered person is transported when medically necessary by ambulance to a hospital.
