AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR RECKLESS DRIVING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 14 of the general statutes be amended to provide for a
- 2 penalty schedule for reckless driving that mirrors the penalty schedule
- 3 for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of drugs or
- 4 alcohol, including fines, periods of suspension for a motor vehicle
- 5 operator's license or nonresident operating privilege, periods of
- 6 incarceration and increased penalties for second, third and subsequent
- 7 violations, except provisions involving the installation of ignition
- 8 interlocking devices, and in lieu of a pretrial impaired driving
- 9 intervention program, require an operator found guilty of reckless
- 10 driving to successfully complete a course of not less than thirty clock
- 11 hours of classroom instruction relative to motor vehicle operation and
- 12 highway safety provided by a licensed drivers' school.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the penalty for reckless driving and deter dangerous behavior.
