## AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY EMPLOYEE AND VOLUNTEER BACKGROUND CHECKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 19a-491c of the general statutes be amended to require 2 that each long-term care facility, prior to extending an offer of 3 employment to, or entering into a contract for the provision of long-term 4 care services with, any individual, or prior to allowing any individual 5 to begin volunteering at such long-term care facility, require that such 6 individual submit to a background search, regardless of whether such 7 individual will have direct access to patients or residents.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prevent elder abuse by requiring all prospective employees and volunteers of long-term care facilities to submit to background checks.
