AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PILOT PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK YOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of 2 Education to establish a pilot program for at-risk youth in grades seven 3 to nine, inclusive, to engage in hands-on, project-based learning 4 programs in the core academic curriculum subjects of mathematics, 5 science, English language arts and social studies that align academic 6 content with practical applications, including vocational and 7 community experience.
