**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PILOT  
PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK YOUTH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Education to establish a pilot program for at-risk youth in grades seven
- 3 to nine, inclusive, to engage in hands-on, project-based learning
- 4 programs in the core academic curriculum subjects of mathematics,
- 5 science, English language arts and social studies that align academic
- 6 content with practical applications, including vocational and
- 7 community experience.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a pilot program for at-risk youth in grades seven to nine,  
inclusive, to engage in hands-on, project-based learning programs that  
align academic content with practical applications, including vocational  
and community experience.
