AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF THE BLACK BEAR POPULATION IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of 2 Energy and Environmental Protection to: (1) Conduct a study, within 3 available resources, to estimate the population and growth rate of bears in the state, and to estimate the biological and cultural carrying 4 5 capacities by region, and to update such estimates each year; (2) publish regulations to prohibit the unintentional feeding of black bears; (3) 6 7 educate the public on proactive measures to prevent human-bear 8 conflict; and (4) establish a hunting season to maintain the bear 9 population within the biological and cultural carrying capacity in each 10 region of the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a bear management framework intended to ensure a healthy bear population, minimize conflicts between bears and humans and allow for limited regulated hunting of black bear.
