AN ACT LIMITING THE PASSPORT TO THE PARKS MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE TO ONE VEHICLE PER HOUSEHOLD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (b) of section 14-49b of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to limit the assessment of the Passport to the Parks motor

3 vehicle registration fee to one charge per household regardless of the

4 number of vehicles such household may own.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide savings to the registrants of vehicles by limiting the assessment of the Passport to the Parks Fee to one vehicle per household.
