## AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCHARGE OF CONTAMINATED WATER INTO THE CONNECTICUT RIVER BY MASSACHUSETTS-BASED ENTITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of 2 Energy and Environmental Protection to study and create a report 3 concerning the discharge of contaminated water by Massachusetts-4 based entities into the Connecticut River and require said agency to 5 issue a recommendation to the Attorney General on bringing legal 6 action against Massachusetts for the remediation, discontinuance and 7 prevention of such discharges.

## Statement of Purpose:

To stop the state of Massachusetts from allowing the discharge of pollutants into the Connecticut River.
