AN ACT CONCERNING DIVERTING A PORTION OF SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE BENEFITS FOR DRUG COUNSELING FOR BENEFICIARIES CONVICTED OF COMMITTING A DRUG-RELATED FELONY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to divert a portion of
- 2 supplemental nutrition assistance benefits to drug counseling for
- 3 beneficiaries convicted of committing a drug-related felony.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide drug counseling to those who are convicted of committing a drug-related felony while receiving state-administered supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits.
