AN ACT CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A PROCESS TO SET SPECIAL EDUCATION TUITION COSTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to establish a process 2 in which the cost of special education tuition is set and may be adjusted, 3 and such cost shall (1) be based on a review of the current and prior year budget for each organization providing special education, (2) be 4 5 uniform across all student program placements, except where 6 customized services are required, (3) for for-profit providers, reflect a 7 predetermined amount of profit that the provider may earn, (4) be 8 increased by no more than an amount equal to the current cost plus an 9 adjustment amount to be determined after the review of the current and 10 prior year budget for each such organization, and (5) be posted on the 11 Department of Education's Internet web site.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce local special education costs by capping special education tuition using a transparent process.
